

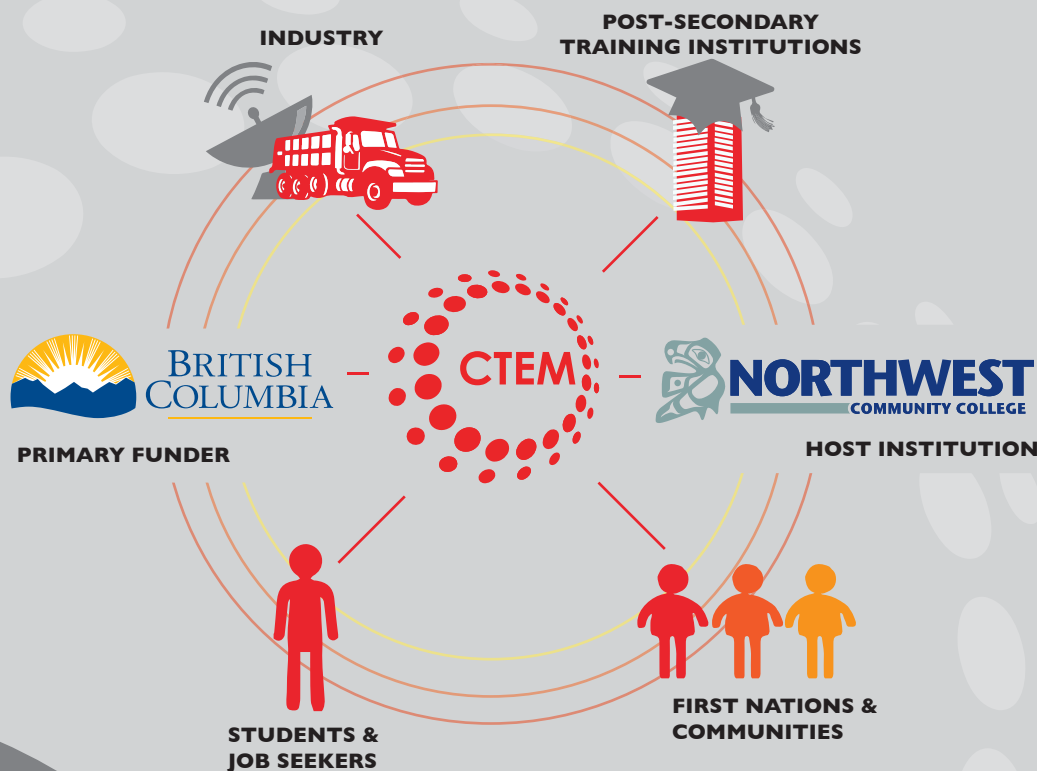
# Centre of Training Excellence in Mining

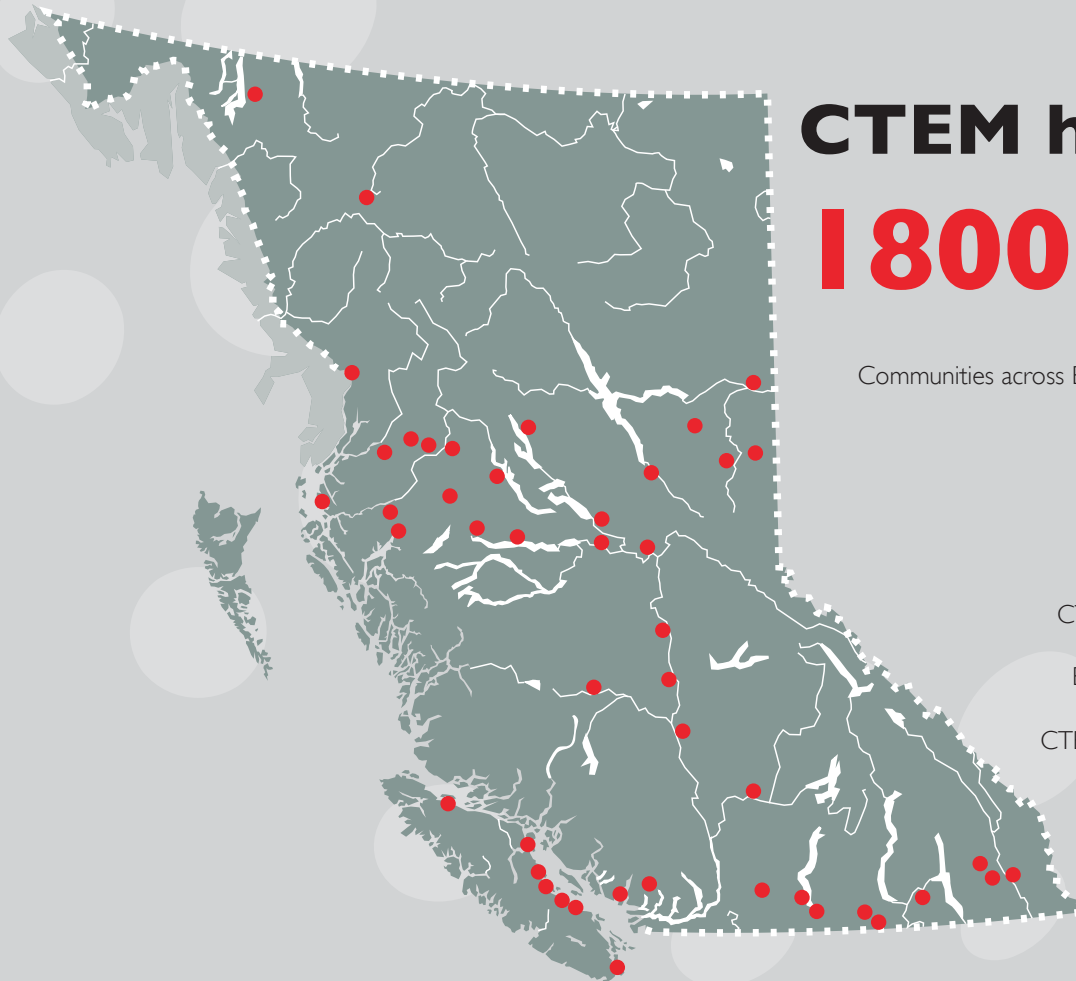
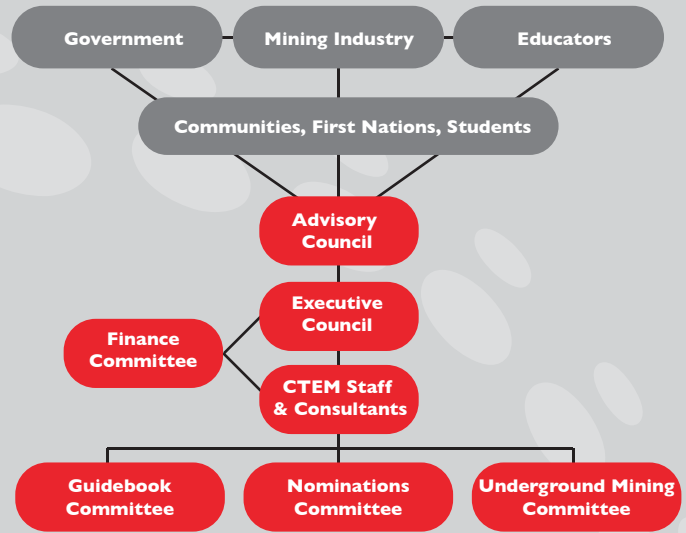
